Island Fox Zinfandel Blush, Puglia, Italy

This is Italy's take on the ever-popular sweet Zinfandel rose that California does so well! It is sweet and juicy with fruit salad flavours, a lighter body and lower alcohol. 11% vol, Vegan

Laroche Rose De La Chevaliere, South of France

Among the bigger, drier, richer styles of rose wines that partner food so well. It has bags of forward raspberry fruit and a real noseful of fresh-pickled berries. 12.5% vol, Vegetarian

Abbaye Saint Hilaire Rose, South of France

A pale dry rose, made primarily from Syrah and Grenache, showing red fruit aromas. Provence is the rockstar of rose, but this wine is also ethically produced in order to hand the vineyards on to future generations. 13% vol, Vegan

Sparkling Wine

Prosecco Spumante Ca'Vescovo, Cervignano del Friuli, Italy

Bright pale straw-yellow; a fine, clear mousse with a very delicate perlage. Attractively intense, very fruity and aromatic, with hints of wisteria lowers and Renet apples. Very well-balanced and appealing, with the extremely delicate almond note that is typical of Giera. 11% vol, Vegan

Joseph Perrier Cuvee Royale Brut

One of the great overachieving, underestimated small Champagne houses. It has a relaxed easy-drinking style with a warm brioche weight to support its fresh appley fruit. 12% vol, Vegan

Pol Roger Brut Reserved, Champagne, France

On the nose, the Champagne is dominated by white flowers, green apple, brioche and a trace of minerality. On the palate there are notes of stone fruits, a certain nuttiness and a hint of honey supporting the freshness of the acidity. 12.5% vol, Vegan
